HEY NOW stalked the leader, had the lead mid way on the turn and with a clear lead from the three path through the stretch was all out for the win. D' ARTAGNAN was in range, roused from between foes on the turn and gained gradually through the stretch while on the rail. BANYAN COURT had no speed, was hustled along from the inside on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch was up for show. MOBY DIP was in touch and raced evenly on the turn but from the four path through the stretch lacked a serious bid. YOGAROO was in mid pack and had a mild gain on the turn but from the four path through the stretch finished in hand. BRUNNERA was hustled early but chased from the inside on the turn and had nothing left. EXCELLENCY was off the pace and showed nothing while never a threat.
