NATIONAL SECURITY was in touch, moved up from the inside on the turn, vied through the stretch and fought gamely for the win. ASYMMETRIC showed speed but was headed on the turn and vied from the three path through the stretch in a good effort. HE DA MAN was off the pace and hustled along from between foes on the turn but from the three path through the stretch was all out. HE'SADREAMCOMETRUE showed no speed, had a good inside position on the turn but needed more. LOVE NEEDS LUCK forced the pace and was a factor from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch evened out. WHYS BEST GUY was hustled early and roused from between foes from the three path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch finished evenly. EIRE'S A RUCKUS was unhurried early and had a mild gain on the turn but was not a factor. MAMBO'S CHARM was well back and showed nothing while outrun. ASAFABOLT stalked the leaders from the outside but lost ground on the turn and was empty.
