BIZNIZ MAN pressed outside and kept close, bid 3-wide on the far turn, took command into the stretch then drew clear and widened to the wire. WONNESOMORE on the inside after saving ground early, gained then was between foes on the turn for home, rallied from the 4-pth and bested the rest. HI POPPY in striking distance and off the rail after going a half, bid 3-wide on the far turn and came home with a mild try. SUNDAY PAGE close early and pressed for the lead from the inside, kept in touch, bid in the drive but needed more. CHOOSE TO PLAY pressed the pace from the outside, was battling for the lead on the far turn then lacked a stretch finish. APOGEE MOON was off the pace and never a threat. ONE CRAFTY CAT had speed for six then tired inside. KING NEPTUNE trailed throughout and showed nothing.
