DESERT DON JUAN stalked the early leader, forced the pace on the far turn and with the lead from the three path through the stretch prevailed. MASTER NOBLE set the pace, had a slim lead into the far turn and vied through the stretch but was no match for the winner. LIQUID LOU tracked the early leaders, raced evenly on the turn and was the best of the rest. MOLINARO JEWEL showed no speed, was roused on the far turn and from the three path through the stretch was up for a share. DANCING GOURMET was unhurried early and trailed the field on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch passed tired foes. CHAPEL ROCK was off the pace and hustled along on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch lacked a rally. CASTLE CLOSE was in touch early but chased from the three path on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch faded. BEAR'S JET was in mid pack and saved ground on the far turn but lacked a late response.
