GO FLY A KITE tracked the speed duel from off the rail, went after the front runner in the drive from the 4-path and got up just in time. IMAMYTO duelled outside of rival and battled on the turn, shook clear, lost whip in early stretch then was caught at the wire. BOSSY settled off the early pace, took to the 5-path turning for home, got into gear and finished fast after finding her best stride late. SOSWEET on the outside in the early going, angled in and was on the rail turning for home, then put in a good rally but failed to outdo the top three. BANKERETTE broke in the air, trailed then came home with a belated outside run. NOTREATSFORYOU was off the pace and did not menace. ROCKS VILLA raced in mid pack then tired on the turn. BETTY'S TREND tracked the speed duel from off the rail, was in the game on the turn then faltered. AMY'S MISS duelled inside of rival and then weakened on the turn then had nothing left.
