ZOUNDS set a pressured pace, took command on the far turn and was kept to task in the stretch. AVOID THE RUSH trailed the field, moved up on the far turn from the inside and closed willingly through the stretch to be second best. KINSTAR was unhurried early, roused from the three path on the far turn, four path at the top of the stretch and needed more. ARMORED was in touch, gained ground from the inside on the far turn, a factor at the top of the stretch but faded late. PRAIRIE HONOUR pressed the leader from between foes, chased on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch. GRANT'S LOVE stalked the leaders from the outside, lost ground on the far turn in a dull effort. COOL PROPOSAL was off the pace, trailed the field on the far turn and was never a threat.
