### Footnotes

DAY OF ATONEMENT tracked the leader from the outset, was still right there turning for home, bid 3-wide in the drive, came in late and bothered inside foe while battling with that one to the wire. CLASSICAL RUCKUS saved ground throughout then bid up the rail in the drive, was bumped by outside rival near the wire and missed. The rider of CLASSICAL RUCKUS lodged a claim of foul against the winner for interference in the stretch run. The STEWARDS disqualified DAY OF ATONEMENT from first, placed second for the bumping incident in deep stretch. DANCE THE GREEN settled off the pace in the early going, was 4-wide and still off the pace into the stretch then rallied wide to clear the others. CAPUCINE between foes on the far turn and in the game, lacked a stretch punch. SUPERTRAMP tracked the two front runners and kept in striking distance into the stretch then failed to fire. OCCATILLA raced well back and showed little. TEMPT HER was off the pace and had no rally. A TWIST OF SHERREE had speed to lead from the break to early stretch then faded.
