STREAKING ECHO closed ground after being settled in the early going, was on the inside and pressing for the lead on the turn, then took charge went clear and was kept to task. SPEAKS VOLUMES veered in at the break and raced off the pace, gained and rallied from the rail in the drive to be clear of the rest at the wire. ARMY DISCHARGE chased the speed from off the rail, kept contact and finished off an even effort. SENSUOUS CINNAMON had speed to lead the way, led into the turn, was pressed inside by the winner entering the stretch then gave way. KIZZY KAZOO came from off the pace to save ground then put in a rail stretch bid to no avail. EILUNEBS DREAM was off the pace and not a threat. BELLE DE NASKRA raced well back and showed little. REGAL SEN faded after being in touch from off the rail early.
