MAKE IT FO unhurried in the early going, gained from the inside on the turn then bid up the rail in the drive and arrived on time. TEXAS BLITZ forced the pace from between foes early, vied on the turn and into the stretch, led briefly then was outdone late. T QUE vied four wide early, kept close on the turn, bid outside the leaders in the drive but did not have enough. MELODY OF GOLD vied from the inside, had a slim lead on the turn, then tired between foes in the run to the wire. VINTAGE YEAR off the pace, angled out and had his best stride late to finish willingly. GILFORD bumped at the break, was outside foes and close up early, tracked on the turn then lacked a serious four path bid. JACKEROO stumbled at the break, was in the hunt early from between foes then backed off into the stretch and tired. FEARLESS BUZZ veered in at the break, bumped rival then trailed.
