MIA'S MIRACLE showed speed from the outside, had the lead in hand on the turn and with a clear lead lead through the stretch proved best. ZLATO stalked the leader, was roused from the inside on the turn and with a mild bid in upper stretch was no match for the winner. COLWOOD was off slow, moved up from the four path on the turn and from the seven path through the stretch was up for show. SUPERBULL was up close and a factor from between foes on the turn but from the four path through the stretch had no finish. SECOND CUP was in touch and hustled from between foes on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch had no kick. AGAIN PLEASE was off slow, trailed the field into the turn and was not a factor.
