DISBELIEF trailed then closed on the turn and was 6-wide and bidding turning for home, rallied strong from there and ran down the leader. ENOUGH IS ENOUGH had inside speed, vied early, had a slim lead on the turn, widened then was run down by the winner in deep stretch. FLAT ROCK never far back, saved ground then had a mild stretch rally to best the rest. KIRRIEMUIR off the pace, gained then bid between foes on the inside turning for home but lacked the needed stretch kick. CHEMISTRY CLASS had an outside trip through the turn, was between rivals into the stretch then had no rally. COOL PROPOSAL stalked the pacesetters and was still a factor on the turn then weakened. SPREAD THE NEWS pressed the pace, backed off on the turn and faded.
