MY SISTER'S PLACE bobbed at the break then pressed the inside leader for six, took command on the far turn then opened a gap and proved best. RARE SOLITAIRE in touch from outside of rival, tracked the leaders on the far turn, split foes in the drive then rallied up the rail to be second best. EMILY SUN SHINE stalked the pace battle in a good trip, bid in the 3-path turning for home and then finished off a good effort. GENTLE in striking distance, was in the hunt in the drive but had no path from the rail, then angled out and finished willingly. COMPADRE'S REBEL led the way while under pressure into the far turn then gave way when challenged and tired inside in the run to the wire. GOSPEL GRINDER was off the pace and not a factor. GLENMOUNT DASH settled off the pace, had a dull try.
