KRZ N' FLASHY had good speed, led at the furlong pole then widened. SIZZLE SIZZLE in touch, had a good rally to be second best. WAY TO RUN had inside speed after a sharp break, was outgunned in the final furlong then held the show. EXPECTED HOUR between foes, put in a good try and finished well. TEXAS BLITZ came out break then vied between but was outfinished. CHICAGO BREEZE squeezed back in the early going, did not menace. NIDAS was off the pace of the leaders and did not find the needed rally. BERMUDA TRIANGLE broke step slow and showed little. SEARCH FOR A HALO broke awkwardly and was not a factor. A STEWARDS' inquiry resulted in the disqualification of TEXAS BLITZ from fifth placed sixth for interference against CHICAGO BREEZE just after the break.
