Footnotes

BEST IN EGBERT was in range, moved up from between foes on the turn and from the four path through the stretch forged clear. PLAYIN'INMYWHISKEY was in mid pack, gained ground from the four path on the turn and from the six path through the stretch had a good effort. TERRAQUANT showed speed, forced the pace from the inside on the turn and vied through the stretch while all out. NOT FOO LING set a pressured pace and had a slim lead on the turn but from the three path through the stretch evened out late. HE DA MAN was in touch and had a good inside position on the turn but from the three path through the stretch needed more. MAMBO'S CHARM had no speed and saved ground on the turn but lacked a serious bid. JUSTCALLMEHUGH broke awkwardly and had a mild gain on the turn but was outrun. ROMAN EMPIRE was hustled from the outside but lost ground from the four path on the turn and had nothing left. WELLSFARGOEXPRESS was off slow and showed nothing while not a factor. THUNDERING BREEZE was off the pace, trailed the field on the turn and was never a threat.
