Footnotes

WIRBELWIND assumed the early lead, drew off on the backstretch and set a reserved pace then widened late under a hand ride. AMATURE NIGHT stalked the pace in hand, chased after WIRBELWIND on the far turn, could not close the gap but was clearly second best. PROUDLY LOUDLY was in range early, raced three-wide throughout, was roused on the far turn but failed threaten while best of the rest. ICEY FROST was far back early, came three-wide through the far turn then passed tiring horses. SILVER SLIVER raced four-wide into the first turn then stalked the pace in hand but could not keep up on the far turn. BELL'S GOLD hit the gate leaving, trailed to the far turn, closed four-wide approaching the stretch but never reached contention. ALACRITY stalked the pace from between horses but lacked a rally. DON'T BE SHY saved ground but was through early.
