HI POPPY unhurried in the early going, gained between foes on the far turn then bid three wide into the stretch, rallied from there and went clear. NUMEROUS LUCK in mid pack, kept in touch, bid up the rail in the drive, was outfinished but ran on willingly. SAYGNITETODABADGUY led the way then was pressured in early stretch and gave way but ran on. FLASHY ADAM chased the speed, kept in touch but had no late off the rail push. ADVERSE WITNESS raced wide early, was off the pace and had no bid. BODEAN in the hunt, was a factor on the far turn then had no rally.
