MY NATALIE set the pace, led in hand on the turn and with mild pressure at the top of the stretch was kept to task. ANNEENA stalked the leader, was a factor on the turn and had a mild bid at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner. WHATYADO was in mid pack, mild gain from the three path on the turn, five path at the top of the stretch but needed more. GLORIOUS MELODY trailed the field early, gained ground on the turn, six path at the top of the stretch and evened out. PRETTY PRETTY GIRL showed no speed, roused from the inside on the turn but lacked a late response. COMPADRE'S REBEL was up close, chased hard from the inside on the turn but leveled off in the stretch. PROMOTION TIME was off the pace and trailed on the turn in a dull effort. EXTRASENSORY was in touch early, lost ground on the turn, six path at the top of the stretch and was outrun.
