COMPADRE'S REBEL stalked the leader, roused from the inside on the turn, was a factor through the stretch and proved best. GRAND BUSTER was off the pace, closed the gap from the inside on the turn and from the three path through the stretch rallied. BINT was in mid pack, had a mild gain on the turn, angled out in mid stretch and finished well. KENDAL MINT was in touch, had a good position on the turn and had a bid at the top of the stretch but weakened late. G T'S GONE DANCING was hustled early and had a clear lead on the turn but gave way late. NASTY FIRE BUG had no speed and was hustled hard from the four path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch had no response. ULTIMATE DREAM was back early, trailed the field on the turn and failed to fire. PLAYFUL DANCE was up close early but lost ground on the turn and came up empty.
