**Footnotes**

BEST OF JOHN stalked the leader, had a slim lead on the turn and from the four path through the stretch drew clear. SENOR UNO was off slow and moved up into the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was no match for the winner. STORMY MARDEN was back early, had a mild gain on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch was up for show. ANNE'S ALPHA BET was up close and a factor from between foes on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch needed more. LOVE NEEDS LUCK was in range and raced evenly from the inside on the turn but lacked a late response. BIDDIE'S FOLLY was off the pace and roused on the turn but failed to menace. ISTROPOLITAN was hustled early and duled from the inside on the turn but tired in mid stretch. PECK ON THE CHEEK was in mid pack and chased from the three path on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had no impact. STONE SENTINEL had no speed and trailed the field on the turn but passed tired foes through the stretch. BEARS NORTHERN was in mid field and hustled on the turn but had no response. EMEE WISDOM was in touch but lost ground into the turn in a dull effort.
