Footnotes

DISTINCTIVE TASTE showed speed from the inside, had a clear lead on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch proved best. RAINBOW EXPRESS was in range, moved up on the far turn and was a factor at the top of the stretch but no match for the winner. ABERFORTH forced the pace and was hustled along on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch finished evenly. BEAR WHITE SOCKS showed no speed, had a mild gain from the three path on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch was all out. SILVER MINIKIN was in touch and raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but lacked a serious bid. PRAYINGALLTHEWAY was unhurried early, showed nothing and was never a threat. CLONLIFFE was off slow, lost ground on the far turn and was empty.
