SPREAD THE NEWS was up close, vied from between foes on the turn and with the lead from the three path through the stretch prevailed. BAKERS WOODS was in mid pack and a factor from the four path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch was second best. RAGING STAR set a pressured pace but backed away on the turn and from the four path through the stretch finished evenly. SIR VIVA was off the pace and roused on the turn but lacked a serious bid. DEPUTY LOR had no speed and trailed on the turn but passed tired foes through the stretch. BANYAN COURT settled off the pace and was hustled along from the four path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch had no impact. D' ARTAGNAN forced the pace but chased from the inside on the turn and had nothing left.
