MYSTICIAN was in touch, a factor from the inside on the turn, had the lead in mid stretch and forged clear. WHEATYNBERT dueled early, had the lead on the turn and vied through the stretch but was outfinished. KILI was unhurried early, saved ground on the turn and was up for show. BLISS POINT broke outward and was hustled along from the four path on the turn but lacked a late response. CASTLE CLOSE was in range and roused from the three path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch had no impact. MY PARISIO showed speed but chased on the turn and from the three path through the stretch came up empty.
