SMALL PROMISES stalked the early pacesetter then drew closer and challenged outside that one on the far turn, dueled into the stretch and then cleared late. DEVASTATING had early speed to show the way, led from off the rail into the far turn, was pressured, dueled into the final furlong then gave way. ROYAL DALLIANCE came from off the pace to close on the leaders into the stretch turn then kept coming with a late 5-path gain. PROSPECTIVE GAL stalked the pace into the far turn and faded. SIGNS OF GLORY raced off the pace and was never close. TO DY FORE trailed and was not a factor.
