BORREGO ROAD set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn, took command through the stretch and drew off. MISHMASH was in range, roused from the inside on the far turn but chased at the top of the stretch and was second best. MR. MAYACCO showed early speed but settled off the leader and from the three path through the stretch finished evenly. GREEN WEAVER was in touch and hustled along from the four path on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch was all out. TRIPLE EIGHT was well back and trailed the field on the far turn but passed tired foes through the stretch. ROYAL FUGITIVE was off the pace and raced evenly from the four path on the far turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch had no impact. RINK RAT was in mid field and hustled along on the far turn but four path at the top of the stretch had no response.
