Footnotes

BITING HUMOUR was off the pace and trailed the field on the turn but rallied best to get up in time. IDEALS AND DREAMS was up close and dueled from the inside on the turn but with the lead through the stretch just missed. WHERE'S RINGO showed no speed, had a mild gain from the three path on the turn and from the seven path at the top of the stretch was up for show. JENPEG was unhurried early, saved ground on the turn but lacked room in mid stretch and finished well. GIMMEA CAN DO IT showed speed and dueled from the outside on the turn but tired in deep stretch. BROMPTON ROAD was back early, raced from the four path on the turn and from the six path through the stretch had a belated rally. BLONDESSILVERDREAM stalked the leaders and was a factor from the three path on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch was all out. MOLINARO FORT was in touch and hustled along from the three path on the turn but from five path at the top of the stretch needed more. O B THE BEST was in mid pack and roused on the turn but from the three path through the stretch evened out. TIZSATION was in range and raced evenly from the inside on the turn but faded late.
