Footnotes

HEY NOW showed speed, vied from between foes on the turn, dueled from the three path through the stretch and fought gamely for the win. IT'SAPOSSIBILITY was away alertly, a factor from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch had a good effort. ACED THE MOVES was unhurried early, had a mild gain on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch finished well. POINTLESS LOVE was off the pace and trailed the field on the turn but from the six path through the stretch gained gradually. COLWOOD was in mid pack and roused from the three path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch had no late kick. IDEALS AND DREAMS tracked the early leaders and had a good inside position on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch leveled off. DOPPLER RADAR was hustled early and dueled from the inside on the turn but was tired at the top of the stretch. OLD BLUE EYES showed no speed and saved ground on the turn in a dull effort.
