KILMOGANNY tracked the leaders, bided his time on the far turn, then angled out, bid four wide and rallied to the win. DUGALD kept in touch and then went up to bid four wide on the far turn, loomed and vied into the stretch only to be outfinished. HIGH PLATEAU tracked the leader, bid between on the far turn then weakened in the run to the wire. SEVENTEEN RED came from well back to gain on the far turn and then had a late six path try. CARABINEER had good speed, opened a gap, was pressured on the far turn then weakened inside. MORE INSPIRATION off the pace, lacked a rally and did not menace. ADMIRABLE NELSON was well back before passing tired ones. SYMPHONY OF FIRE backed away after being in the early hunt and outside. TOOTAINTE had early contact then tired. RIGHTLY ROYAL showed little in an off the pace run.
