### Footnotes

QUICK KID was in mid field, hustled hard from the three path on the far turn and from the four path through the stretch was up in time. BOLD PHIL was away alertly, set the pace and had a clear lead on the far turn but failed to hold. IRISH APPROVAL was in mid pack and moved up from the three path on the far turn but finished evenly through the stretch. NAUGHTS NOT KNOTS was off the pace and lacked room on the far turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch closed. DISCREET DECISION had no speed and was roused from the four path on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had no kick. STONE SENTINEL was unhurried early, trailed the field on the far turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch was not a factor. LOVER BOY stumbled at the start and was a factor from the three path on the far turn but tired in upper stretch. NON SEQUITUR was in range but chased from between foes on the far turn and flattened out through the stretch. BIDDIE'S FOLLY stalked the leader early and raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but was outrun.
