Footnotes

WORTH A PUNT was unhurried early, moved up from the three path on the far turn and from the four path through the stretch was all out for the win. EXCALIBUR was in range, roused from between foes on the far turn and from the three path through the stretch finished well. HIGH PLATEAU pressed the leader, had a slim lead on the far turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch had a good effort. CAN'T BE PETE was off the pace, hustled hard from the four path on the far turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch closed. RED AND BOLD set a pressured pace and was a factor from the inside on the far turn but weakened through the stretch. POINT TUPPER had no speed and was hustled from between foes on the turn but from the three path through the stretch had a dull effort. SABINO broke inward, trailed the field on the far turn but passed tired foes through the stretch. ARMORED was in touch and raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but lacked a late response. VENABLO was in mid pack but lost ground on the far turn and was empty.
