PADRE BRAD set the pace, was pressured on the turn, vied through the stretch and fought gamely for the win. MEGACODE was in range, forced the pace on the turn, a factor through the stretch and was the best of the rest. BULLET BOY stalked the leaders, was roused from the three path on the turn, five path at the top of the stretch and needed more. J LAWSON was in mid field, hustled from the three path on the turn, six path at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. CHAIN REACTION was up close, chased from the inside on the turn and tired through the stretch. REASON AND RHYME trailed the field early, had a mild gain on the backstretch and from the five path at the top of the stretch was outrun. UNION EXECUTIVE had no speed, raced evenly on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch had no kick. BOLD AS HECK was in mid pack, hustled along from the inside but had no response. ANNE'S ALPHA BET was well back, showed little and had no impact. IGNAC NOT IGGY was unhurried early, failed to fire and was no factor. GIMMEA CAN DO IT was off the pace, trailed the field on the turn and was never in contention. OFF THE RECORD was back early, showed nothing and was not a factor.
