TEE KAY ODE stalked the leaders, bid between foes turning for home, gained the lead then was full out to prevail over outside rival. M J'S STAR came from off the pace to close and was five wide on the turn for home, bid from there and put in a solid try but missed. JUICED came from the inside and mid pack to split foes in the stretch then finished willingly. STRIKE THE HARP vied outside and was a factor turning for home then gave way in an off the rail drive. HEADER FOR HOME dueled for the lead while inside of foe, battled on the turn then weakened inside. BACKINTHEBUSINESS was off the pace and did not fire. NEON STROKES outside foes and looming three wide on the turn, tired. HIGHLAND SOLACE was off the pace and never a threat.
