BITTER ENDING had speed from the break to open a gap, maintained it throughout and was never in doubt while being kept to task. FOXS CONSORT saved ground before making a mild 3-path stretch run to get up for the place. TOUCH OF JAZZ chased the speed and tracked into the stretch then had an inside run and stayed for the show. DOS CHICAS raced in mid pack and was in touch before finishing wide and not threatening the top three. AH T L AFFAIR bumped at the break, was off the pace before putting in a rail stretch run to no avail. TAGS AND TOWEL raced wide early, was in mid pack on the turn then lacked a five path rally. RUNNING DOTTIET off the pace, trailed the field home.
