HE DA MAN showed speed from the inside, vied on the turn and with the lead at the top of the stretch was kept to task. WHYS BEST GUY stalked the leaders from the outside, was a factor from the three path on the turn and with a bid from the five path at the top of the stretch had a good effort. MR TAMBERINE MAN set a pressured pace, dueled on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was the best of the rest. CASTLE CLOSE was in mid pack and raced evenly on the turn but from the six path through the stretch needed more. EIRE'S A RUCKUS was up close and hustled along from the inside on the turn but had no response. WINDFIELDS LEGACY was off the pace and showed little in a dull effort. THAT'S MY ZACKIE had no speed, showed nothing and was never a threat.
