Footnotes

PLAYIN'INMYWHISKEY was unhurried early, moved up on the turn and from the seven path at the top of the stretch proved best. TERRAQUANT set a pressured pace and had a slim lead on the turn but was headed in deep stretch and was second best. THE MIGHTY SPARROW was in touch, had a good inside position on the turn and finished well in deep stretch. LOVE NEEDS LUCK was away alertly and a factor from the three path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch needed more. RIVER CARD was in range and roused from the four path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch had no response. PRINCE OF ASCOT forced the pace but chased from between foes on the turn and was tired at the top of the stretch. DOING IT MY WAY was well back and showed nothing while never in contention.
