OCALA SON set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn and widened under light handling through the stretch. ONE THOUSAND PLUS was in range and moved up on the turn but from the four path through the stretch was clearly second best. FREEDOMBID was in touch and roused from between foes on the turn but had no late kick. BEST IN EGBERT was off the pace and had mild gain on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had no impact. IRISH APPROVAL was well back and hustled along from the three path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was not a factor. PHILJO was hustled early but dropped back on the turn and had nothing left. OCALA SON WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
