**Footnotes**

EVOLUTION ROCKS showed speed and set the pace, had a clear lead in mid stretch and prevailed. BEST OF JOHN tracked the leader, was a factor from the inside on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was up for place. EUCLID AVENUE was up close and roused from between foes on the turn but from the three path through the stretch was all out. FOXY TWO SOCKS was in range and had a good position from the three path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch finished evenly. TOBERMORY was off the pace and had a mild gain on the turn but from the five path through the stretch needed more. GET THE PATIENCE was in mid filed and raced evenly from the four path on the turn but lacked a serious bid. WHO BY FIRE was in mid field and hustled along from the four path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch had no response. A HOTTY AT NOON was well back and showed little while not a factor. STRIKE OIL was off the pace and showed nothing while never a threat.
