**Footnotes**

WITH ALL DILIGENCE kept in touch while on the inside into the far turn, angled out to bid 3-wide, caught the leaders at the furlong pole then drew off. MADAME ARABELLA bobbled at the break, kept close and then dueled into the stretch, could not match the winner but ran on willingly to be second best. SKATING HOME had good inside speed, had the lead after going a half then vied on the far turn only to weaken from the rail in the drive. PUZZLE DREAM tracked the leader and then was a factor after going six but had no stretch kick. GENNY'S BEST trailed in the early going, passed a tired one then had no stretch impact. LADY CELIA taken back off the pace after breaking smartly, settled near the rear of the field and was never a factor.
