### Footnotes

TICKET TIME was hustled early, set the pace and with a clear lead through the stretch was much the best. HIGHS AND LOWS was in mid pack, had a mild gain on the turn and from the five path through the stretch was up for place. BEAR'S SONG stalked the leader and had a good position on the turn but leveled off in mid stretch. JAZZUNTA had no speed, closed the gap from the five path on the turn but from the eight path through the stretch had no kick. LITTLE MISS TOMMI was off the pace and had a mild gain from the four path on the turn but from the seven path through the stretch needed more. MADIMAC was in range and raced evenly from the four path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch lacked a serious bid. CHERRY RING POP was up close but chased from between foes on the turn and from the five path through the stretch had nothing left. SILVER MANCER was in touch and hustled along from the inside on the turn but had no response. SWEET MAY WEST was unhurried early and pulled up on the turn.
