REPUTED DEEDS had early speed and held sway, was pressed from the rail into the far turn, kept on the engine, staved off inside foe and prevailed. DANCE SLIGHTLY never far back, bid inside into the far turn, forced the pace into the stretch then finished off a solid inside try. CELTIC RIDE in mid pack, saved ground on the far turn then failed to match the top two in the drive while best of the rest. FAR AND NEAR up close, pressed the pace from the outside, kept contact on the far turn from off the rail but had no finish. NUMEROUS LADY trailed early, was never close and not a threat. MEET IN MIAMI was off the pace and never a factor. SPUNKY BOTTOMS backed away after being in touch early.
