FASTER THAN FLASH had inside speed and a slim lead on the turn, turned back outside challenger and proved best in the drive. JIMMY THE LINK had good outside, pressed the pace into the stretch, could not get by the winner but finished off a good try. COMPADRE STRIKES on the pace early and between foes, backed off then came home with a rail stretch effort. MIDNIGHT PLAYER in mid pack, had a mild rally from the four path. MASTER MANIPULATOR trailed then had a belated run to no avail. STRETCHDRIVE on the outside and an early factor, evened out. DANZIGS TRICK off the pace and in the three path on the stretch turn, lacked a kick. REGALLY RED was well back and never close.
