ARCTIC GOLD RUSH asked w/o response. MOONLIGHT SPECIALTY lacked experience. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON MIDNIGHT JUSTICE AGAINST HOLLAND ANNIE HOME FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN MID STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON TWENTY FOUR CORONA AGAINST HOLLAND ANNIE HOME FOR INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH RESULTED IN HOLLAND ANNIE HOME BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FIFTH.
