RAGING STAR was unhurried early, moved up from the inside on the turn and with the lead at the top of the stretch prevailed. ITSWHATWELIVEFORE was in mid pack, had a mild gain from the inside on the turn and finished well but just missed. PADRAIG showed no speed, was roused from the inside on the turn and gained gradually through the stretch. BULLET BOY was off the pace and trailed the field from the three path on the turn but from the seven path through the stretch passed tired foes. AGAIN PLEASE set a pressured pace and had the lead on the turn but from the six path through the stretch weakened. DUGALD was in range and raced evenly from the four path on the turn but from the seven path through the stretch had no kick. KWIK COSTA was in touch and roused from between foes on the turn but from the six path through the stretch had no response. CROWN OF GLORY showed speed but chased on the turn and from the four path through the stretch came up empty.
