FREEZE ALERT unhurried in the early going, bided his time, gained on the far turn then rallied down the 4-path to catch the leader in deep stretch and go clear. CHRIS'S BAD BOY had speed to stay with the leader, went to the inside of that one after going a half, bid and took command, held the lead into the final furlong then failed to last from the rail. BOGART gained ground through the far turn and finished up with a mild stretch bid. ORIGINAL ONE had speed to lead for a half, took on inside pressure on the turn was no match and faded. INSPIRED CALL raced off the pace and was never close. SYNDICATE BLUES broke awkwardly, trailed and showed little.
