### Footnotes

BE A BULL was unhurried early, moved up from the inside on the turn, had the lead in mid stretch and drew clear. BEST IN EGBERT was in touch, raced evenly from the four path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch finished well. FEDERAL EXCHANGE was hustled early from the inside, had a slim lead on the turn and vied to mid stretch but was outfinished. BEYOND MY CONTROL was up close and forced the pace on the turn but from the three path through the stretch tired late. PRETTYPRETTYPLEASE showed no speed and had a mild gain from the three path on the turn but from the seven path through the stretch needed more. ACTIONONHETEE showed speed but chased on the turn and from the three path through the stretch had nothing left. HARDROAD TO HEAVEN was well back, trailed the field on the turn and lacked a serious bid. BEAR AND ROD was off the pace, showed little and from the eight path through the stretch was not a factor. MAN IN BROWN SUIT was in range but lost ground on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was empty.
