Footnotes

HOLLYWOOD BEAR broke awkwardly, was a factor from the three path on the turn and proved best through the stretch. BOO BOO'S LOVE stalked the leaders, raced evenly on the turn and was up for place. BROMPTON ROAD showed speed, was roused from the inside on the turn and vied in upper stretch but weakened late. PAUL BUNYAN was off the pace and hustled along from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch needed more. COX'S EVENT was in range and roused from the three path on the turn but lacked a late response. BEL LARGO stumbled at the start, had a slim lead from between foes on the turn but from the four path through the stretch gave way. MOLINARO IRISHLINE was hustled early and saved ground on the turn but failed to fire. ULTERIOR MOTIVE was up close early but trailed on the turn and was outrun.
