MOBY DIP settled off the pace, moved up from the four path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch rallied. FIONN was in touch, a factor from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was up for place. IT'S TIME BEAR was in range, gained ground from the inside on the turn and had a bid in deep stretch but was outfinished. BUCK CASH was off the pace, roused from the inside on the turn and angled out through the stretch but needed more. MOLINARO COMPARO stalked the leader and had a good position on the turn but from the three path through the stretch faded late. ALMOSTOUTOFTHEBLUE was in mid pack and roused from the three path on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had no kick. EXPLOSIVE GREEK set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn and vied through the stretch but weakened late. WILD SUNDAY (GB) showed no speed and raced evenly from between foes on the turn but failed to fire.
