JUMPTOCONCLUSIONS had no speed, was roused from the three path on the turn and from the six path through the stretch was up in time. HEREISTHERING was in mid pack, a factor from the four path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch just missed. BELLA CREEK was back early, had a mild gain on the turn from the inside and closed willingly in deep stretch. SWEET SAMBUCA was up close, hustled along on the turn and had a bid through the stretch but was not enough. REGAL DIAMOND was away alertly, led on the turn and with pressure through the stretch was outfinished. CENT T MINT trailed the field, saved ground on the turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. STILL SHARP stalked the leader, chased from the three path on the turn and flattened out in the stretch. I SEE ROCKETS was off the pace, trailed the field on the turn and was never as threat.
