PURE REY (ARG) was in touch, moved up on the far turn and from the seven path at the top of the stretch fought gamely for the win. MR. HENRY TWO U stalked the leader, had a slim lead on the far turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch was outgunned. DUGALD was in mid field, raced evenly from the three path on the far turn and lacked a kick. PARABOLA showed no speed, was hustled along from the three path on the far turn and finished evenly. FIJI BOY trailed the field, was roused on the far turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch needed more. APALACHEE STORM set the pace and vied on the far turn but tired in upper stretch. KAHANAMOKU was in range, saved ground on the far turn and failed to fire. TAP SHOW was in mid pack, lost ground on the far turn in a dull effort. CELTIC THANE was off the pace, backed away on the far turn and was empty.
