QUICK KID was in range, moved up from the three path on the far turn and from the five path through the stretch proved best. SUMMER IN GIZA stalked the leader and had a clear lead on the far turn but from the three path through the stretch failed to hold. COLWOOD was in mid pack, a factor on the far turn and raced from the four path at the top of the stretch but angled to the inside and finished evenly. OROCOMO was in mid field and gained ground from the four path on the far turn but from the seven path through the stretch had no kick. BUDDHA MASTER was well back, closed the gap from the five path on the far turn but from the eight path through the stretch had no impact. HARDROAD TO HEAVEN was unhurried and hustled on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch failed to fire. BORREGO ROAD was off the pace and raced from the four path on the far turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch lacked a rally. GOLDY SONG was in touch but chased from between foes on the far turn and was outrun. NORDIC DANCER set the pace but lost ground on the far turn and came up empty.
