Footnotes

GAS N DASH stalked the early leader, was a factor on the turn and from the three path through the stretch was up in time. SUNDAY PRINCE set the pace and led in hand on the turn but with a clear lead in mid stretch was caught late. DURLINGVILLE was in mid pack, raced evenly on the turn and from the three path through the stretch finished well. GANTU settled off the early leaders and was roused from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch was all out. PHILLY FRENZY showed no speed and saved ground on the turn but needed more. ZENKO was off the pace, showed little and had no impact. COLE'S GOT SOUL was up close and chased from the inside on the turn but came up empty through the stretch.
